

RS to take up triple talaq bill for consideration today

NEW DELHI: The government has listed the contentious triple talaq bill for consideration and passage in Rajya Sabha on Tuesday. The bill has already been passed by Lok Sabha by a voice vote amidst a walkout by Congress, Samajwadi Party, Trinamool Congress, DMK and others. The bill was passed by the 16th Lok

Sabha but could not pass the Rajya Sabha hurdle. The ruling BJP has issued a whip to its MPs, asking them to ensure their presence in the House. The bill, which criminalises instant divorce by Muslim men and seeks jail term for the guilty, was the first draft legislation tabled by the Modi government in this first session.

NAIDU CALLS FOR GUIDELINES ON SCRUTINY OF BILLS

NEW DELHI: Rajya Sabha Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu on Monday denied the Opposition charge of allowing hurried passage of the legislations and suggested a need for codification of guidelines on the scrutiny of Bills by Parliamentary committees. In a 6-page response to 15 MPs of the Rajya Sabha belonging to 14 parties expressing anguish over passing of many Bills in the current session without scrutiny, he said the Chair has nothing to do with the reference to the select committees as that is the prerogative of the House while no standing committees have been constituted yet to let him refer some of the Bills to them. The standing committees have members of both the Houses and not yet constituted since members of the new LS are not yet nominated. Suggesting formation of a committee for codification of guidelines on scrutiny of the Bills, the Chairman said: "It can't be anybody's case that every Bill should be subjected to scrutiny by one or the other parliamentary committee."

Azam Khan says sorry, Rama Devi not happy

Samajwadi Party leader Azam Khan on Monday apologized to BJP's Rama Devi for his objectionable comment against her in the Lok Sabha last week but the latter did not seem mollified. As the House assembled, Speaker Om Birla asked Khan, elected from Uttar Pradesh's Rampur, to speak. "The whole House knows my speech and conduct. Despite that if the Chair feels that I had done a wrong, then I apologize for that." He said he had been Parliamentary Affairs Minister twice and Minister four times. "I have been MLA nine times and have been a Rajya Sabha member too." Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi requested Speaker to ask Khan to apologize in a

"proper way". Noting that Khan's words had "insulted all women across the society as well as women members" of the House, Joshi said: "I appeal that he (Khan) should apologize in a proper way and end the issue." Birla then asked Khan to apologize again. Reiterating his earlier

statement, Khan said: "I had said it earlier too that Rama Devi is my sister... It is not possible for me to disrespect the chair. Despite that... I apologise." Participating in a discussion on the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill, 2019 on July 25, Khan made a remark direct-

ed at Rama Devi, who was presiding over the House, drawing objections from the treasury benches and others too. Rama Devi, a member from Bihar's Sheohar, herself objected to the sexist remark and ordered it be expunged from Parliamentary records. The next day, Lok Sabha members unanimously condemned Khan's comment and demanded "exemplary" action against him. On Monday, the Speaker asked Rama Devi to speak. Still upset over Khan's remark, she said his comments had hurt both women and men across the country. "Azam Khan will not understand the pain I felt because he keeps passing such comments outside too. His conduct is not good. But we want betterment in Azam Khan's conduct."

PANAJI: The issue of Samajwadi Party leader Azam Khan's controversial sexist comment directed at acting Lok Sabha Speaker Rama Devi, echoed in the Goa Legislative Assembly on Monday. Sudin Dhavalikar, the Maharashtra Gomantak Party MLA who served as Deputy CM in Parrikar-led cabinet, alleged that he was abused by a minister in front of late CM during a cabinet meeting. "I condemn Azam Khan's comments on Rama Devi. Something similar happened during a cabinet meeting chaired by the then Chief Minister Manohar Parrikar, when the Art and Culture Minister abused me. The CM should inquire into the incident," Dhavalikar demanded.

The rape survivor, the police said, was assigned nine security personnel, including a gunman. Suresh, told NDTV that the security personnel were asked to stay back as "there was no space in the car". "It was not an accident but a conspiracy to eliminate all of us... The son of a co-accused in the case, Shahi Singh, and another youth of the village had threatened us," the teen's mother was quoted as saying by PTV. "I have got to know that the lawmaker got it done. He is doing everything from inside jail," she said. Tagging a media report on the accident, Congress leader, Rahul Gandhi tweeted: "Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao. A new special education bulletin for Indian women. Don't ask questions if a BJP MLA is accused of having raped you." Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra described the incident as shocking and SP leader Akhilesh Yadav has sought a CBI probe. "So a woman is allegedly raped by a BJP MLA. Her father is beaten up and dies in custody. A key witness died mysteriously last year. Now her aunt who was also a witness is killed and her lawyer is critically injured in an accident caused by a truck with blackened number plates," Priyanka tweeted. "She (the rape survivor) herself lies grievously wounded in hospital. The accused continues as a BJP legislator, and the BJP State Government has the audacity to run a 'Bhay-mukt Uttar Pradesh' campaign?" the Congress leader said in another tweet.

Shastri on Monday made a tongue-in-cheek comment about the conspiracy theories. "Very soon you will hear wires batting and bowling. The way this team plays, no individual is bigger than the game. Not me, not him, nobody in the team. I have been a part of that dressing room and none of the nonsense is there," the commentator in the former all-rounder stepped out as he pooh-poohed the rumours.

selection committee's pleasure," Gavaskar said. "To the best of our knowledge his (Kohli's) appointment was till the World Cup. After that, it was incumbent on the selectors to meet, even if it was for five minutes, for his reappointment," he added. However, the MSK Prasad led selection committee simply named Kohli as captain of the team across all the three formats for the Windies tour that starts with T20Is. Further, the Supreme Court-appointed Committee of Administrators (CoA) has stated that they will not review the performance of the team in the showpiece event and only the manager's report will be looked into. Gavaskar also went ahead and questioned the way Kohli was being allowed to pick his team.

Death cut to life term

A bench of Justices Bhushan Dharmadhikari and Swapna Joshi granted a breather to Pradeep Kokade (30) and Purshottam Borate (37) after considering the delay on the part of both the governments in completing all the procedures for executing the death sentence. The duo was originally scheduled to be hanged on June 24. However, they moved the bench citing the delay of over four years in executing their sentence. They highlighted the fact that despite the judgement of the Sessions court in 2012 and its subsequent confirmation by the HC as well as the Supreme Court till 2015, the authorities failed to follow the procedures. On the other hand, the authorities, including the ministry of home affairs, maintained they had exchanged several letters to follow procedure and forwarded the mercy petitions filed by the duo before the President as well as the Governor. The President had rejected the mercy petitions in June 2017. However, due to some 'miscommunication', the death warrant could only be obtained in May 2019. Taking note of all the letter work, the judges said, "Telegrams or express letters were used years ago, as these were the fastest mode of communication available then. Now it has to be email, fax or telephone or video-conferencing etc. Not resorting to these devices in the digital era would tantamount to deliberately delaying the exercise or derailing it. It would be an instance of avoidable delay." "When the protection accorded by Article 21 of the Constitution of India is at stake, the executive, court or the governor or President stand on the same pedestal," Justice Dharmadhikari observed in the judgement. The bench further noted that in all the letters exchanged between the authorities, the words "most urgent" or "death penalty" are printed on the top. However, it appears that the matter was not given the attention it deserved, the court said. "Delay by any arm of the state would be against the fundamental right of the convict. Extra or additional punishment resulting from avoidable delay cannot be legalised because it is on account of undue time taken by the constitutional functionaries. Such additional punishment is unconstitutional in all circumstances and contingencies," the judges said. The bench noted that from 2015 till date, only two years was consumed in deciding the mercy petitions (by the governor and President). But there is no explanation for the remaining three-year delay.

Taking the winds away from Yediyurappa's sails, the Speaker stunned the Assembly saying "I have decided to relieve myself from this office... I have decided to resign. I am handing over my resignation letter to the Deputy Speaker Krishna Reddy". Without waiting for a reaction from the stunned Assembly, he sprang out. Behind Kumar's move was the BJP threat to vote him out of office in the coming days if he does not step down. Raising his voice, Kumar said during his 14-month-long tenure as the Speaker, he had worked according to his "conscience" and in accordance with the Constitution. "I have upheld the dignity of office to the best of my ability."


'Stray' cows will cost owners dear

However, according to the new proposal, it is a crime to tether animals. The existing penalty amount was approved by the BMC on March 1, 2004. Now, 15 years later, the administration is planning to increase the penalty amount. Earlier, the fine was Rs 2, 500 for large animals, and now it will be Rs 10,000. For stray calves, the earlier fine was Rs 1,500, which will now be Rs 6,000. The proposal further states, these fines are being increased since the catching of stray livestock involves huge expenditure, with the use of animal catches, municipal vehicles, staff, fuel and then their transportation to the animal prison at Malad. These expenses will be covered by the proposed penalty. The hike in penalty has been proposed by the corporator Nehal Shah and will be implemented after the approval of the standing committee.

Tax rise for high earners may trigger fund flight: Bimal Jalan

Former Reserve Bank of India (RBI) governor, Bimal Jalan, has warned that the higher income taxes the government introduced in its budget could lead to a flight of funds from the country. "In theory if tax rates are very high, obviously people look for other countries, which have lower interest rates, and also exemptions from income tax," said Jalan, 77, who is chairing a central bank panel deciding on how much of the RBI's reserves should be transferred to the government. rupees a year now pay 30% of their earnings as income tax plus an additional 4% on the amount of taxes paid. According to the new budget, people and trusts earning more than 5 million rupees a year will pay an additional 10% surcharge and 15% for those earning more than 10 million rupees. "The incentive to borrow or invest domestically is certainly impacted by higher taxes. So investors may be sending money overseas, but hopefully it does not lead to round tripping," Jalan told Reuters in an interview on Sunday, referring to funds exiting only to come back, and evading taxes along the way.

Azam Khan is now charged with grabbing land for a luxury resort

Slapped with 26 fresh cases of land grabbing, Samajwadi Party MP Azam Khan has got involved in yet another multi-crore land scam. On July 29, the UP Irrigation Department served him a notice, alleging that Khan's luxury resort, Humsafar, located in Rampur, is built on land owned by the state government.

The Enforcement Department is also enquiring into alleged money laundering charges related to donations from abroad in account of Khan's private University.

Supintendent of Police (Rampur) Ajay Pal Sharma said the police have sought the revenue records, payment receipts and land agreements with different parties from whom the land, running into several hundred acres, was purchased. "We need to investigate the sale deeds and verify authentic documents to ascertain the actual seller. We also want to assess the accounts through which the payments were made. The parties which received the payments have to be authenticated," said the SP. Sources in the police said that apprehending arrest, Azam Khan has not visited Rampur for the past one month. "For the first time in the recent years, Azam Khan has not been seen in his constituency for so many days," said a police official. Azam(70), has been an MLA from Rampur for nine terms. He was first elected on a Janta Dal (Secular) ticket from Rampur in 1980. He has been cabinet minister in UP several times.

Amid the unease in the Congress against the current drift, Rahul Gandhi has remained firm on not having a member of the party's first family as the working president despite growing voices in support of Priyanka Gandhi to take over. As the joust between an adamant old guard and a defiant young turks club plays out, the Congress remains headless and rudderless, exposed by its inherent contradictions. The old guard is firmly behind Priyanka Gandhi's elevation despite a section of young leaders backing Rahul Gandhi's plan. Even as Rahul opposes a family member at the helm, her Sonbhadra

show has won her many admirers both in the party and outside. The cabal around Sonia Gandhi is insistent that they have a winner on their hands after Priyanka's intervention in UP. This remains unacceptable to Rahul. Punjab chief minister Captain Amarinder Singh and Thiruvananthapuram MP Shashi Tharoor were among the leaders who supported Priyanka Gandhi. Amarinder Singh said on Monday that Priyanka Gandhi would be a perfect choice, but the decision rests on the Congress Working Committee (CWC). "Priyanka is an excellent choice for the next President who will enjoy all-round support. Agree with

Shashi Tharoor that her natural charisma would galvanise the workers and voters alike. Hope the CWC decides on it soon," he said. Priyanka Gandhi has been active in taking on the BJP government in Uttar Pradesh. She has been firing a salvo a day against the Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. According to many leaders, the delay in appointing a working president is hurting the party which is rudderless at the moment.
